The Golden Standard

The past few years have been challenging—especially with staffing shortages worsening during and after the pandemic—but God's provision has been constant.

We've recently received Employee Retention Credit checks from the IRS—a long-awaited blessing that feels like a powerful reminder of how sustenance often comes after a season of struggle. We've also seen a long-overdue increase in our Medicaid reimbursement rate, which better reflects the costs of the high-quality care we provide. And, most recently, we were awarded another three-year accreditation through the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities. The feedback from our surveyors, including phrases like "Harbor House is the Golden Standard," proved as testimony to the dedication and loyalty of those committed to the mission and vision of our organization.
